You will need to complete an NSW Police Declaration (P650) prior to the course. If you answer **<u>YES</u>** to any of the following questions, you **<u>must</u>** contact NSW Firearms Registry **<u>before</u>** you can participate in a Firearms Training Course or handle / use a firearm:

Have you been refused or had a firearms licence suspended or cancelled? Are you subject to a firearms prohibition order? Have you been convicted of a criminal offence in the past 10 years? Are you suffering from serious mental illness or ever attempted suicide? Are you the subject of a Good Behaviour Bond or an AVO?

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SAFE HANDLING COURSE PARTICIPANTS TRAINING CONDITIONS

The following are the obligations for the TLMPC, the Trainers and the Course Participants.

OUR CLUB

The TLMPC will provide all items required for the course including safety equipment such as hearing protection (ear muffs) and safety glasses, pistols and ammunition and the NSWAPA P650 Training Booklet, as well as a licenced qualified trainer for each participant (1 on 1 training) in safe and approved ranges and facilities. The club will provide all necessary public indemnity insurance.

TRAINER

The trainer will be appropriately qualified as required by Firearm Registry and ensure all safety and legal requirements are adhered to at all times.

The trainer will cease all training at any time should a serious safety breach by the trainee occur Any incident will be discussed with the Course Convenor / Club Official.

TRAINEE

Course participants must complete the P650 declaration and complete/answer all declarations, forms and questions posed by the Club in a truthful and correct manner.

Course participants must follow all instructions given by a trainer and follow all club range rules that will be explained at the commencement of the course.

All trainees must provide suitable photographic identification

• A photo ID (such as an NSW Driver's License or Australian Passport)

If the trainee is a minor (12–18 years of age) and does not possess a form of photo identification then the parent or legal guardian must supply the above photographic proof of identity to the satisfaction of the Course Convenor / Club Official.

A fee of \$50 is payable in advance and is refundable should a trainee join the TLMPC following the course. A trainee must attend at least two practice sessions before applying for membership. To maintain a Pistol Licence a licence holder must participate in at least 6 shoots a year.
